Charles W. Calomiris is the Henry Kaufman Professor of Financial Institutions at the Columbia University Graduate School of Business and a Professor at Columbia's School of International and Public Affairs. Professor Calomiris co-directs the Project on Financial Deregulation at the American Enterprise Institute.

Professor Calomiris's recent publications include two edited volumes, *Sustaining India's Growth Miracle* (co-editor) and *China's Financial Transition at a Crossroads*, a co-authored book, *Emerging Financial Markets*, and articles including “Capital Flows, Financial Crises, and Public Policy,” in *Globalization: What's New*, and “Blueprints for a New Global Financial Architecture” in *International Financial Markets: The Challenge of Globalization*. In addition to teaching international banking and corporate finance at the MBA and Ph.D. levels at Columbia, he has taught an MBA course in Business Values and Ethics and Ph.D.-level courses, including one on Emerging Financial Markets, at the World Bank and the IMF.
